+ FROM THE PASTOR +

This month we are celebrating the 500th anniversary of the Reformation. The Theme for the national church and our congregation is: "Celebrating 500 Years of God's Grace in Action." These days are special because they serve as a wonderful reminder of the rediscovery of the Grace of God. It is not that the grace of God was not there, then or now, because God's grace has always been active, even before creation, but all too often we forget it is present.

The time of the Reformation was a remarkable time of change and transformation. The truth of the light of the Gospel was rediscovered and the darkness of corruption was driven back into the shadows, waiting for a more opportune time. Things were set into motion that changed the western church and culture dramatically. It was truly amazing, but then grace is always amazing.

God is and always has done remarkable things in the world and in his church and most of that has been done through people like you and me. And this too was one of the great rediscoveries of the Reformation. God works through ordinary people who in faith answer his call to follow him. This following does not always require us to serve in difficult ways or religious service but by simple acts of faith and love.

This month we will have several opportunities to learn more about our heritage of faith and since this is also our stewardship month there will be opportunities to think about how we live out our faith through the amazing grace of God.

COUNCIL HIGHLIGHTS



The Congregational Council met on Wednesday, September 13. After a devotion by Maggie Muff and a leadership moment by Pastor Berg we began with a review of finances. YTD income and expense were on track with projections but we are still very close to the edge and need to do a little better in the income area. It was also reported that \$832 was raised at the Chamber music concert to be split between Calvary and the SLO Youth Symphony.

We discussed budget concerns for 2018. We also discussed the need to review salaries due to a lack of raises for several years and the need to balance that with the fact that we cannot keep drawing from our reserves. We are going to have to seriously work on this in the coming year. We talked about fundraising ideas and decided to wait until the beginning of the year for those.

It was noted that Pastor will be out of town for several weekdays during October for family times, as well as Police Department Training. <u>He will not miss any Sundays</u>. Other items covered were the painting of the Fellowship Hall exterior but no date has been established. It was decided that we need to have the Fellowship Hall carpet cleaned (that happened on September 25). We also reviewed coming events and assigned people to help with those.



REFORMATION FESTIVAL

On this 500th anniversary of Martin Luther nailing his 95 theses to the Wittenberg church door and setting off the Reformation, we will be having a special celebration festival on Sunday, October 29th. There will be a special worship service followed by a Potluck. As part of this festival you are being encouraged to participate in the spirit of the Reformation by spreading the Word. **F.A.N. THE FLAME** by bringing a Friend, Associate, or Neighbor to our festival. You are also encouraged to wear red, the color of the day – to help our celebration be even more festive!

STEWARDSHIP SUNDAY, OCTOBER 15TH "Be A Part of God's Grace in Action"

This year our stewardship theme challenges us to think about our part in the work of God. God has richly blessed us as individuals and as a community of faith with every blessing in the heavenly realms. This year as we think about the 500 year history of the Lutheran Church and our roots of faith, it is time for us to ask how we will continue to be part of God's Amazing Grace? Our lives are full of this grace and we are



challenged to think about how we will use these blessings for his work in our lives and world. Join us for Stewardship Sunday worship service and special presentation focusing on how God is leading us forward in his world.

Those present will receive their stewardship packets with details as to our needs and goals for the coming year. (If you are unable to be with us, packets will be mailed to you.) We are asking that you return your pledge cards and your Time and Talent sheets as part of our offering on the following Sunday, October 22nd which is "Generosity Sunday". If you cannot be present with us on that day we ask that you return those items to us by mail as soon as possible. This information makes it possible for us to more accurately plan for the coming year, so we would like to hear from everyone. Your help is what makes all that we do possible as we seek to serve Christ.



OPERATION CHRISTMAS CHILD

Again this year we will be packing shoebox gifts to be distributed through Operation Christmas Child. The shoeboxes may contain small toys, school supplies, hygiene items, small clothing items, etc. You can help in several different ways:



- (1) You can pack a shoebox yourself including the \$9 shipping cost.
- (2) You may purchase small items and put them in the collection box in the entryway to be packed into shoeboxes.
- (3) You may donate money to buy supplies and/or to help cover shipping costs for shoeboxes.
- (4) Pray for the children who will receive these gifts, for their families and for those who distribute these very special gifts.

The shoeboxes are distributed to children around the world who have probably never received a Christmas gift, they are also used to introduce the Gospel to these children to help sow the seeds of faith in their communities. All items need to be at church by November 12^{th} so we can fill the shoeboxes and get them delivered during national collection week which is November $13^{th} - 20^{th}$. For more information pick up a brochure in the entryway or talk to Aldina Dunn, or Nancy Berg. Our collection box is looking pretty empty so please help us out so we have enough items to pack as many shoeboxes as possible!


